## MEMORIAL PLAQUE UNVEILED ON SEPTEMBER 22, 2025 AT THE CHURCH OF SAINT HILAIRE DE NALLIERS



### Message from the president



Greetings to all the members of the Association.

As I write these lines, the Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2025 has just taken place on October 12th, 2025, at the Cabane à sucre Chabot, in Neuville. It was a warm gathering attended by about 50 people (see pp. 18-20).

On this occasion, a souvenir **slideshow** of the journey to our roots in France, which took place from September 11 to 25, was presented. The slideshow highlighted **four significant moments** for the Chabot.

- 1) On September 17th, we visited the church of Ste-Madeleine de la Ventrouze, place of baptism of Marie Mésangé, wife of Mathurin. The church is in great need of restoration. Perhaps we could help this small town of 140 inhabitants in their effort to restore it (pp. 4-5).
- 2) On September 19th, we admired the *Logis de la Chabotterie*, family estate of noble Chabots and historic site of Vendée (p.6).
- **3)** Then, on **September 21st**, we explored **Jarnac** and learned more about its history and the noble Chabot who ruled there, including Baron Guy Chabot and his famous *coup de Jarnac* (p. 7).
- 4) On September 22nd, we travelled to Saint Hilaire de Nalliers, birthplace of Mathurin. We participated in the blessing, by the parish priest, Father Dominique Lubot, of the memorial plaque. We were received there with generosity (pp. 15-17).

At the AGM, we also paid posthumous tribute to the late Claude Chabot, in the presence of members of his family including his wife, Francine Carbonneau, and his two daughters, Julie and Nancy. Coinciding with the departure of Jean-Marc Chabot and Claude Dion from the Board of Directors, Julie Chabot, eager to help and to carry on her father's work, joined the Board as Vice-President. Julie's involvement delighted everyone and was seen as an additional sign of confidence in the Association's future. She

brings valuable experience, having previously served on a board of directors. Moreover, her expertise as a team leader in the Client Services Division at the Quebec National Business Register will be very useful. We already appreciate her cheerfulness. I would now like to extend an open invitation to anyone who would like to support the work of the Board's team in one of the many tasks that keep us busy throughout the year.
