Message from the president



Greetings to all members of the Association des Chabot.

2026 Annual General Meeting

The AGM will take place on **September 26**, in St-Charles-de-Bellechasse. On this occasion, as we did in 2023 with the family of

Louis Chabot (1882–1971) and in 2024 with that of Adrien Chabot (1920–1984), we will introduce you to the **Family of Jean-Paul Chabot** (1923–2020). Since 1752, with the arrival of Jean Chabot, grandson of Mathurin, this family has been established in St-Charles-de-Bellechasse. It will be very interesting to hear André, Jean-Paul's son, give this presentation in words and images.

Our genealogist, Diane Chabot-Pard, will be on hand to answer questions from those present. We will also continue the tradition of welcoming Chabot artisans so they can share their work with us. We will also give a fresh update on the restoration project for the Église Ste-Madeleine-de-la-Ventrouze, the birthplace of our ancestor Marie Mésangé — a restoration for which we have raised funds.

In addition, around mealtime, we will enjoy a musical performance by a violin-piano duo, **Bruno Chabot and Caroline Veillette** (see p. 11). These two seasoned musicians will delight us with a repertoire as refined as it is varied.

St-Charles is a parish where many of our ancestors lived. In Brother's Keeper, Diane Chabot-Pard has traced more than 400 Chabots born and more than 200 Chabots buried there.

After the meal, we will be able to learn more; thanks to photos of gravestones taken by Claude Dion, and about the Chabots who served as church wardens from father to son there.

In this issue, you will meet five Chabots, five fascinating people, each in their own way and just as interesting as one another.

First (p.4-7), you will discover **D^r Julia Chabot**, a physician and musician who, through music, has innovated in the care of older adults, including those suffering from Alzheimer's disease, and who, as president of the Association of Geriatricians, alerts us to the challenges of Quebec's aging population.

Next, meet **Simon Chabot** (p. 8-10), a talented 20-year-old who shines in Quebec and France in the field of oratorical dueling. His discipline is called "battle rap." The son of a writer, he introduces us to a surprising area of counterculture.

Then, **René Chabot**, a resident of St-Damien and native of St-Lazare-de-Bellechasse, describes (p. 12-13) the first part of the story of his life and his contribution to the development of the magnificent Bellechasse Golf Club.

Thanks to research by Diane Chabot-Pard, you will learn more about **Monique Chabot** (p. 14) and her husband Guy Sanche (Bobino).

Finally (p. 15-17), we will discover the admirable career of **Louise Chabot**, a native of St-Charles-de-Bellechasse, who was in turn a nurse, president of a labor federation (CSQ), and a Member of the House of Commons.

Our great family is rich in stories and achievements. Let's keep discovering it and making it known.
